## Transportation from Ben-Gurion Airport to Jerusalem

**Shared Taxi (*Sherut*):** Neshar offers a 24-hour daily transportation service from Ben-Gurion Airport to your address in Jerusalem. Reservations are not necessary. The taxis (vans that take up to 10 passengers) are available outside of the G level of Terminal 3.

Price per passenger: NIS 64

**Bus:** 485 (operated by Afikim Bus Company) between Ben-Gurion Airport and Jerusalem. The 485 bus runs hourly, 24 hours a day on Sunday-Thursday. It does not run during the Jewish Sabbath, so on Friday service stops around 14:00, beginning again on Saturday evening around 20:00 (depending on the season). Bus stops are located outside on the second level of Terminal 3 and at Terminal 1.

Ticket price: NIS 16

You will need to take a taxi or other form of transportation once you arrive in Jerusalem, opposite the Central Bus Station, by the Binyanei Ha'uma International Convention Center.

**Mount Scopus:** Bus 68

**Edmond J. Safra (Givat Ram) campus:** Bus 68, 14, 66, 9

**Ein Kerem medical campus (Hadassah):** Take the light rail to the Mount Herzl station and transfer (free) to Bus 27 **or**

Take the light rail to Jaffa center and switch to bus No. 19 from king George street.

**Guatemala Apartments:** Take the light rail to the Mount Herzl station and transfer (free) to bus 24, 35 or 10. Get off at the Kiryat Hayovel shopping center and head down Guatemala Street until you reach No. 11, where the Student Housing office is located.

### **Transportation from Ben-Gurion Airport to Rehovot, Faculty of Agriculture, Food and Environment:**

**Train:** Take the train from Ben-Gurion Airport to the Tel Aviv Hahagana station. Transfer to platform 2 and take the train to Rehovot (E. Hadar). The campus is a short walk from there.

The Hebrew University offers its students a variety of housing options in Jerusalem and Rehovot. Currently, there are 5,500 beds: 3,350 in single rooms, 2,000 in shared rooms and 200 in apartments for families. Some buildings have been designated for graduate students.

## Registration and Payment Arrangements (for Single Students)

Registration for student housing is dependent on the availability of space and the criteria for eligibility set by the Student Housing Services, which can be viewed on its website at: <https://dorms.huji.ac.il>.

The housing registration process takes place online. Please follow the instructions listed below.

**Note:** Students who wish to receive application forms through regular mail and/or to make payments at the Postal Bank should contact the student housing staff.

Pay the non-refundable registration fee of NIS 100 online at: <https://dorms.huji.ac.il>. Payment by the given date will guarantee you a place in student housing. On the application form you must specify your personal housing preferences.

- A response to your application will generally be sent to you by email within 30 days after payment of the registration fee.
- Together with this response you will receive a request to make an advance payment of NIS 1,100.
- Completion of the advance payment by the specified date will guarantee you a place in your assigned housing complex. The sum of this payment will be deducted from your first rent payment.
- After completing the advance payment you will receive the following:
  1. A detailed housing referral (including your check-in date and details about the housing complex).
  2. Standing order form to debit your bank account, which must be signed by your bank and then sent to the fax number specified on the form before your check-in day.
  3. A list of the items that you must bring to check-in: personal passport-size photo, ID card (*teudat zehut*) or passport, standing order form signed by the bank, confirmation that the advance payment has been paid.

- **Families/Couples Housing:**

The first step of the application process is to pay the non-refundable registration fee through our website: <https://dorms.huji.ac.il>.

You are then required to submit the completed application forms for family housing (which can be found on our website) together with a

copy of your ID card (*teudat zehut*) or passport, in person or via email or fax to the Student Housing Services head office. Be sure to submit these forms by the given deadline; otherwise your request will be considered only after all of the applicants who submitted their requests on time have been allocated housing.

Please be sure to specify your personal preferences through our website during the registration process: housing for singles or families, requested campus, religious/non-religious building, single or double occupancy.

The preferences of all applicants will be taken into consideration within the framework of the possibilities available at the different campuses.

The Student Housing Services will make every effort to fulfill your requests; however, in light of the complexity of the allocation process, we may not be able to fulfill all requests.

### **Cancellation of Registration**

If you cancel your registration for student housing for any reason, a refund of the advance payment will be issued as follows:

**Full refund of the advance payment:** If you paid the advance payment and notified the Student Housing Services that you wish to cancel your housing registration by August 31, you will be issued a full refund of the advance payment provided that you have not yet “used” student housing. (“Use of student housing” will be considered residing in student housing even a single day, signing a contract and/or receiving a key.)

**Half refund of the advance payment:** If you notify the Student Housing Services that you wish to cancel your housing registration from September 1 until one day before your check-in date (specified in your housing referral), you will be issued a refund of half the amount of the advance payment in December.
