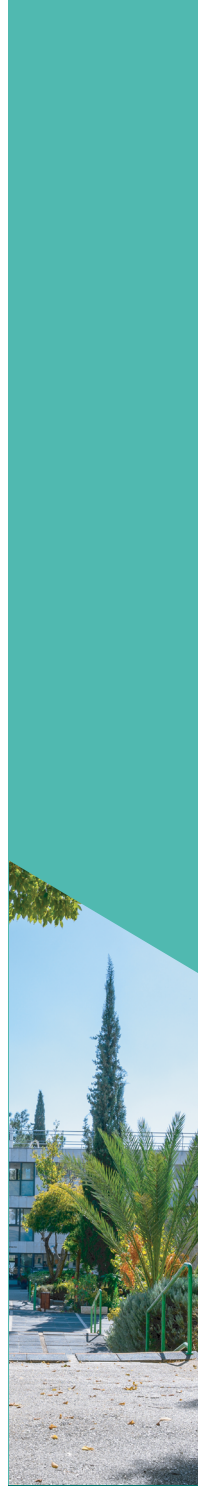

Who is eligible for student housing?

Students of all disciplines who are enrolled in the Hebrew University as regular students or students of the pre-academic programs (e.g. the Hebrew University prep programs) as described in the student housing [code of practice](#) (Regulations) the code of practice is revised from time to time.

Number of years of eligibility by program

Program	Number of years
(Bachelor) undergraduate	up to 4 years
Conversion to master's degree	up to two years
(Master's degree) graduate	up to 3 years
Conversion to doctorate degree	up to two years
(Doctorate) postgraduate	up to 5 years
Professional certificate program	full academic year
Students of other academic institutions	up to 4 years

Total maximum eligibility for student housing: up to 10 years.

Residents of Jerusalem and the Jerusalem area are also eligible.

Exceptional requests and/or appeals regarding University decisions will be considered by the Dean of Students Office.

Registration & room assignment

Rooms are assigned by computer raffle based on the campus in which the student will be enrolled the following year. If you register early for student housing you will receive priority at your preferred dormitory (compliant with the criteria).

The dormitory administration makes an effort to assign students to a dormitory near the campus in which they will be studying. If, for any reason, you have not been assigned a dormitory near your campus, you may ask for a transfer to another dormitory (see Applying for a Transfer/Reassignment, below).

Students who are ineligible for student housing based on the criteria listed in this brochure (external college students, interns, guests) may be offered space in the dormitory based on availability in accordance with Hebrew University policy and with the approval of the Dormitory Administration.

Registration and payment procedures (singles)*

To register for student housing in the following academic year, please be sure to follow the procedures described below in the order they are listed

1. Looking for student housing? Please sign up on the student housing website <https://dorms.huji.ac.il>

There is a non-refundable NIS 150 registration fee.

2. Responses to registration applications will be sent within about 30 days of registration together with a payment request for a NIS 1,500 down payment.

3. Paying your down payment on time guarantees a reserved place in the dormitory you will be assigned.

4. The sum of your down payment will be deducted from your first rent payment.

• Failing to pay the down payment by the deadline revokes your dormitory eligibility.

5. Rent is charged once a month for the following month. Usually, rent is charged on the 21st of the month and utility fees (where applicable) are charged retroactively for the previous month. Your first charge will include rent from the date you moved in and the following month, after deduction of the paid down payment.

6. Once you have paid your down payment you will receive:

a. A dormitory assignment voucher (with check-in date, information of your assigned dormitory and dormitory coordinator)

b. A standing order form to be signed by your bank (direct debit). Before your check-in date, please send the signed standing order form to the fax number listed on the form. Alternatively, you can authorize a credit-card standing order via the student housing website: <https://dorms.huji.ac.il>

Please bring with you when you check-in at your dormitory: a passport photo, ID card or passport, signed standing order form, receipt for paid down payment.

To ensure that our team can provide the best service, please include your personal preferences when you sign up on the website: Once you have paid the down payment, special requests can be addressed directly to the dormitory coordinator who will do their best to comply. Please note that we are unable to reserve specific rooms.

Applying for transfer or reassignment

Requests for reassignment to another dormitory (**before check-in date**) can be submitted via the dormitories website once you have received your room assignment and have paid the NIS 1,500 down payment. **We are not able to process reassignment requests if the down payment has not been paid.** The dormitory administration will make every effort to approve requested reassignments. The changes will be made on the basis of available space and according to order of priorities which takes into account the urgency of the change and the date of submission of the application.

Applications for internal transfer within a dormitory after check-in:

After you have checked in at your dormitory, you may apply for a transfer within the same dormitory or to another dormitory. During the period between check-in week (one week before the opening of the year) and two weeks into the year we are unable to process reassignment and transfer applications. Do submit your application to your own dormitory office, but they will be processed after this period.



Accessible dormitories

There are a number of accessible rooms or apartments for residents with special needs. The dormitory administration approves these based on suitable certification provided by the students and room availability. The Dean of Students Office has an accessibility unit which coordinates these special applications.

The procedure for submitting special requests is as follows:

- a.** Fill in a standard application for student housing.
- b.** At the same time contact the Accessibility Unit by email: negishut@savion.huji.ac.il tel. 02-5880118 on Sun.-Wed. 8:00am-1:00pm. Please include suitable medical documents to explain the grounds for your request.
- c.** After consideration, the accessibility unit will send its recommendation to the dormitory administration.
- d.** The dormitory administration will check whether suitable housing is available in the requested dormitory and will send the student an answer. The approved housing is non-transferrable and remains valid for one academic year.

Notes:

- a. The approval process may be lengthy, so we recommend initiating it as early as possible.**
- b.** The dormitory administration will make every effort to approve special requests. However, we are unable to guarantee that the requested dormitory will be assigned.
- c.** Being assigned an accessible dormitory does not exempt you from full rent as listed in the rent table in your residence contract.
- d.** In certain cases the accessibility unit may consult a professional unit about a specific application.
- e. Applications for accessible housing must be resubmitted every year.**

Cancellation procedure

The following cancellation policy applies to students who decide to give up their place in the dormitory for any reason, or whose studies at the University have been cancelled by the University:

1. The registration fee is non-refundable (NIS 150)
2. **Full refund of down payment:** Until August 1st of each year, you can cancel the dormitory through the dormitory website and receive a full refund of the deposit (1,500 NIs).
3. Please submit the application to cancel your student housing via the student housing website- [Application to cancel dorm](#)
4. **Partial refund of down payment:** Starting on August 2nd of each year and up to September 1st, you can cancel the dormitory through the dormitory website and receive a refund of half of the advance payment.
5. After 01.09, there will be no option for an advance refund at all.

The registration fee is non-refundable in any case.

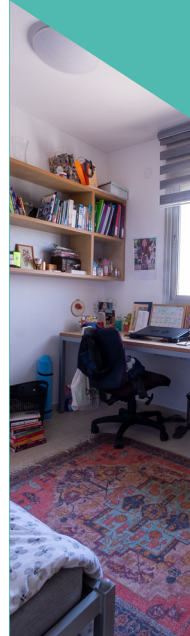

- Deadline for submitting documents for couple/family housing: May 14, 2023.
- Deadline for canceling 2023-2024 dormitory registration: Tuesday, August 01, 2023.
- 2022-2023 residence contract for singles/families expires: Thursday, September 14, 2023.

2023-2024 new residence contract expires:
Wednesday, September 18, 2024.
