Heating -Kiryat Hayovel:

Water heating: All apartments are equipped with a gas water heater for heating water on demand.

Heating: All apartments in the Guatemala and Stern dormitories (with the exception of Building 11 which has electric heaters) are equipped with air-conditioners and include an allowance of 8 hours of electrical heating per day in the winter.

Winter: part of November (starting when the heating system is activated in all University dormitories), December, January, February, March. The electricity meters in each apartment are read every two months and the electricity allowance is deducted from the total consumption. The remainder is divided among the residents and charged via their standing orders.

Hot water Central Heating

There is no electricity allowance in the summer and residents pay for all air-conditioning use.

Stern dormitory

For your safety, we have installed a fire-detection system in all the apartments.

To ensure your safety, do not cover or damage the smoke detectors. Disabling a smoke detector is a serious breach of dormitory regulations and general safety rules.

The air-conditioning system in all the apartments is centrally programmed to either heat or cool depending on the season. As this is a closed system, unplugging an air-conditioning unit causes malfunctions and noise in the central system.

Please do not unplug the air-conditioning unit.

Please keep the showers well-ventilated to prevent mold.

Please note:

- You may not removing furniture from the room and apartment or move closets inside the rooms.
- Do not switch rooms without written approval from the office.
